From my own experiences of child sexual assault I know for a fact the police do nothing to protect u from offenders.

It should not matter if your attackers are good at sport or not. Rape is Rape!

I have been laughed at, assaulted and treated worse than my attackers by police in NSW. No man is aloud to touch me even if they have a gun and badge.

It took me so many years to get compensation and I went through absolute hell to get nowhere near as what I'm entitled to by law as the police never kept records, even about when I was gang raped at around 5 years old and those rapists never spent one day in jail the police just laughed at me. I had a bladder infection until I was around 16 because of it.

When I was gang raped and nearly murdered at 17 the police again protected my rapists, even tho the rapists dealt drugs, did robberies, gang bashed people etc, and became famous for gang rape.

Now I'm an alcoholic, my father died from all the stress the rapists caused when I was 19 and my mother is ill.

The rapists were going to blow our house up and police gave them my name and address and protected them.

So train police better or deport them.

Also police should check on all children at school and especially sports as NRL players are child gang rapists and police know, the police protect them as they are so good at sport, but really NRL players are drug cheats and in organised crime we all know.
